Medicolegal Experience

I have over 10 years of experience of working as a psychiatric expert.

Approximately 150 medicolegal reports per annum:

- 80% Personal Injury; Claimant:Defendant ratio is approximately 75:25
- 20% Clinical Negligence cases
- Court attendance: now only occasional; prior to legal reforms was 10 times per annum.
- I am a member of a medicolegal CPD peer supervision group.

Areas of expertise:

1. Post Traumatic Stress Disorder and Travel Phobias

I have over 15 years of experience of assessing and treating these conditions; I am the consultant lead for PTSD for 2gether NHS Foundation Trust.

2. Mood disorders including depressive illness & bipolar disorder

I have over 15 years of experience in the psychiatric assessment and management of mood disorders; I regularly assess and treat these conditions, both as part of my NHS work and in my private clinics.

3. Psychotic disorders including schizophrenia

My NHS work focuses on assessment and treatment of emerging psychotic disorders, although there is much comorbidity with other conditions.

4. Alcohol and Substance Misuse

I regularly assess and treat these disorders, both as the sole presenting disorder and as a comorbid condition. I hold an Addiction Psychiatry endorsement to my Certificate of Completion of Training.

5. Patients with comorbid physical conditions including pain, and Somatoform/Conversions disorders

My wider NHS role and my private practice encompasses assessment and treatment of patients with these conditions

6. Personality disorder

I frequently assess and treat patients with personality disorder, either as a primary or a secondary diagnosis.
